- Employees of federal, provincial, territorial or municipal Information and Privacy oversight or administrating offices, as well as their family members, are not eligible to enter this contest.
- All questions must be answered in order to be eligible for entry.

- All entries must be postmarked on or before October 2, 2009 and received by 4:30 pm Atlantic standard time on October 9, 2009.
- Nova Scotia Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Review Office employees will select the winning entry.
- The winning entry will be drawn from those quizzes with the highest score.
- One prize will be awarded to the winning contestant. The prize will consist of one portable DVD player and two access to information themed movies.
- The winner will be notified October 16, 2009.
- Participants in the Nova Scotia Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Review Office Right to Know Week 2009 Contest are required to provide personal information. The information collected from a contestant is strictly voluntary but a requirement for entry in the Contest and includes contact information such as the contestant's name, telephone number and postal address.
